**COST: \$4,995.00**

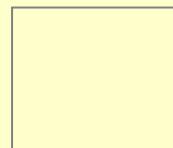
The cost covers:

## July 5 - 12, 2011

Get closer to the Alaskan Brown Bear in a wilder setting than any other place in the world. Kukak and Hallo Bays are remote areas in the Katmai National Park, where the Alaskan Brown Bear spends the summer feasting on the huge salmon runs and raising their cubs. This boat-based tour, led by Mark Garbutt, is for a very small group (max. 6 participants) to access some of the most remote locations in the park.

Hip waders are provided for shore excursions. Participants should be in moderate physical condition and able to walk in shallow water, in rough terrain, and in muddy conditions for up to 2 miles. We ask participants to be in sound health and bring with them a positive attitude and sense of adventure in a wild, outdoor environment.



## Itinerary

Participants should plan their arrival into Anchorage in time to attend the evening information meeting on July 4, 2011. Please do not book departure flights before 9:00 PM on the final day, July 12, 2011. The detailed itinerary is as follows:

### July 5th 7:00 - 9:00 pm

Meet & Greet at Anchorage hotel. Hotel room included. (Meals on your own)

### July 6th

Early morning departure from Anchorage airport to Kodiak (flight cost not included). In Kodiak, connect with float plane charter flight to Kukak Bay to board the Coastal Explorer (L&D)

### July 7 - 11th

With the Coastal Explorer as our base, we will travel the coast of Katmai, spending nights in sheltered bays. There will be numerous excursions via Zodiak to the shore where you will be equipped with hip boots to explore the wildlife in the area. Photograph bears (hopefully with cubs), eagles and a vast array of wildlife and scenery (B,L,D)

### July 12th

We'll travel back to Kodiak today, in time to catch the flight back to Anchorage, and the late evening flights out of Anchorage to your home destination.

### Additional Details:

The Coastal Explorer I is an excursion ship that accommodates 6 guests plus the captain, cook and photography guide. Previous participants have described the food as exceptional, and with advance notice we will do our best to accommodate any allergies or special requests. Sorry, no single supplements as the cabins on-board are designed for 2 people.

The trip involves watching wildlife in their natural habitat, from both the water and while onshore. Safety is our utmost concern and we require that all guests heed the rules and directions of the staff at all times. Very few people in the world have the opportunity to view these animals in such an intimate format and we are privileged to be among the few.
